St Botolph's Hall is located off Bishopsgate, between Liverpool Street Station and London Wall. From Liverpool Street Station take the Bishopsgate exit and turn right at the top of the escalators onto Bishopsgate. St Botolph's is located (on the right) a 2-3 minute walk away. Walk down the pathway in front of the church to the Hall.

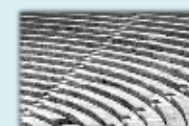
